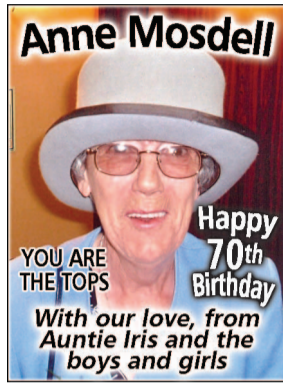


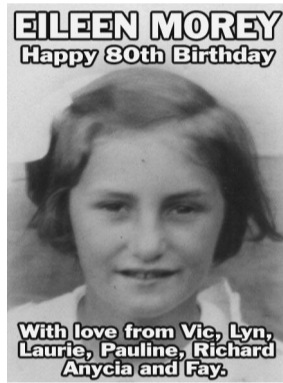

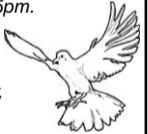
HOLT Peter John
