We collected the death certificate and personal items at the hospital, and arranged a time at Northwood House to register her death the next day, but had a message to phone a couple from the mainland, who were in possession of a home-made will, leaving Gwen's estate to them, and we were requested to give up every last possession, including the death certificate, which was to be given back. It saddened me, we were not allowed to arrange our family funeral ourselves. Gwen did not have much to show for her life, and the only things I would have liked to have the photographs of our family history. At least Jack (my son) had a cushion back that he had given Gwen for her birthday, that he requested, so he could remember her with. Thanks to the hospital staff, especially Caroline, who cared for Gwen. If all nurses were as good as her, the NHS would be excellent. Thanks also to my mum, who saw too many tears, Jack and Margaret, who kept my business going for me during this awful time, and not least, Dave my partner, who kept me going when things were hard to bear.
